MUST HAVES:

- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, deodorant, etc)
- Towels and washcloths
- Swimming suit and sandals
- Flashlight and batteries
- Paper, pen or pencil, and BIBLE
- Shoes appropriate for hiking, running
- Sunscreen
- Insect Repellent
- Prescription medications (All prescription medications, except inhalers, must be checked in w/the director at registration). Please be sure to fill out medical information thoroughly.

NICE TO HAVE:

- Possibly rain gear (check the weather for Lacey, WA before you leave)
- Camera
- Musical Instrument
- Stationary and postage stamps
- Personal CD Players / iPods *may* be allowed for use in cabins at specific times with your counselor's approval (however we are not responsible for lost, stolen, or broken items).

NOT ALLOWED:

- Alcohol...Drugs...Cigarettes/Tobacco products...Firearms...Fireworks...Weapons of any kind.
- Cell phones, Radios. **Cell phones must be off and put away throughout camp. Your counselors will set wake up alarms. We will confiscate cell phones and keep them till the end of the week.**
- Candy, food or beverages.

Please Note: We will enforce the Regional Policy of NO SMOKING. Violators will be sent home. This is a serious issue at Gwinwood with all the trees and dry brush.

Camp Check-In begins on Monday, July 12 at 9 AM (camp officially begins at 10:00AM). Please honor these times and do not arrive early...we will not be ready for you. The first meal is lunch.

Camp ends on Saturday, July 17 at 11 AM. Please plan to stay for the entire week. If you must leave early for a special reason, please make arrangements with the director before camp begins. Letters being sent to you at camp should be addressed as follows:

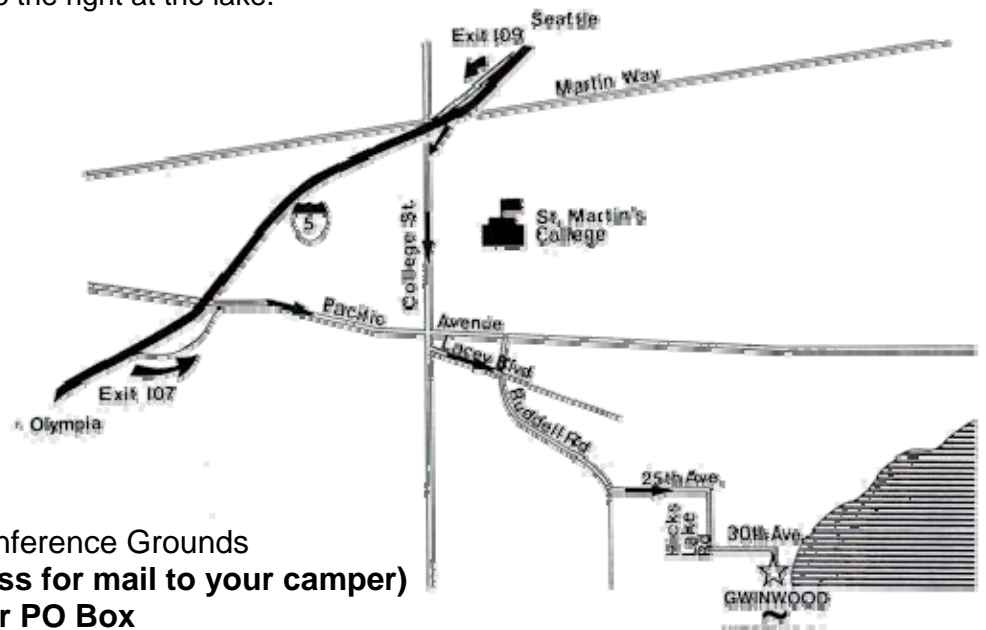

Directions to Gwinwood Conference Center

- Take I-5 to Exit 109, Martin Way.
 - If traveling south on I-5, take a right at the exit.
 - If traveling north, turn left at the exit.
- Move into the left turn lane and turn left at the light onto College Street.
- Turn left onto Lacey Boulevard.
- Turn right onto Ruddell Road. Travel on Ruddell Road for about a mile.
- Turn left on 25th Avenue (there is no light at 25th).
- Turn right onto Hicks Lake Road.
- Follow Hicks Lake around, turning left at the "T."
- Gwinwood is located to the right at the lake.
