Swim suit

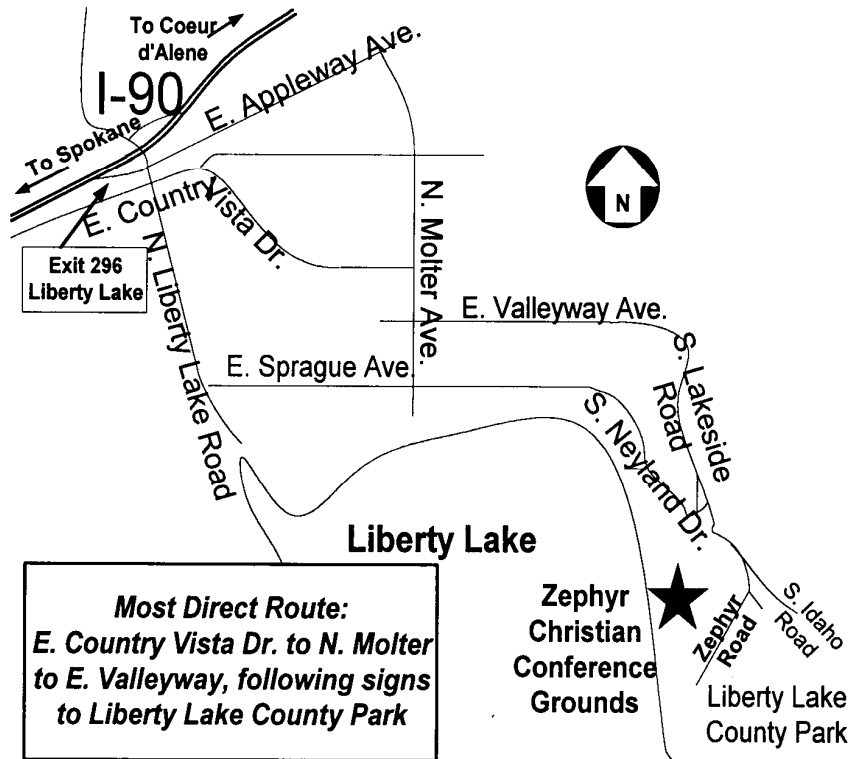
Sunscreen
