Directions

Koinonia is centrally located in the Cascade Mountains range of Washington State. The camp is just off I-90, 25 miles East of Snoqualmie Pass and 7 miles West of Cle Elum. Take exist 78 (Golf Course Road) turning south, then cross the railroad tracks. Proceed up the hill and then turn right at the first road (Nelson Siding Road). Drive west for about a 1/2 mile and watch for the camp sign in the Y or bend in the road. Proceed down this road and across the irrigation conduit via the bridge. Just across the bridge is a sign for your orientation of the camp.

Drive time from Seattle is about 2 hours.
